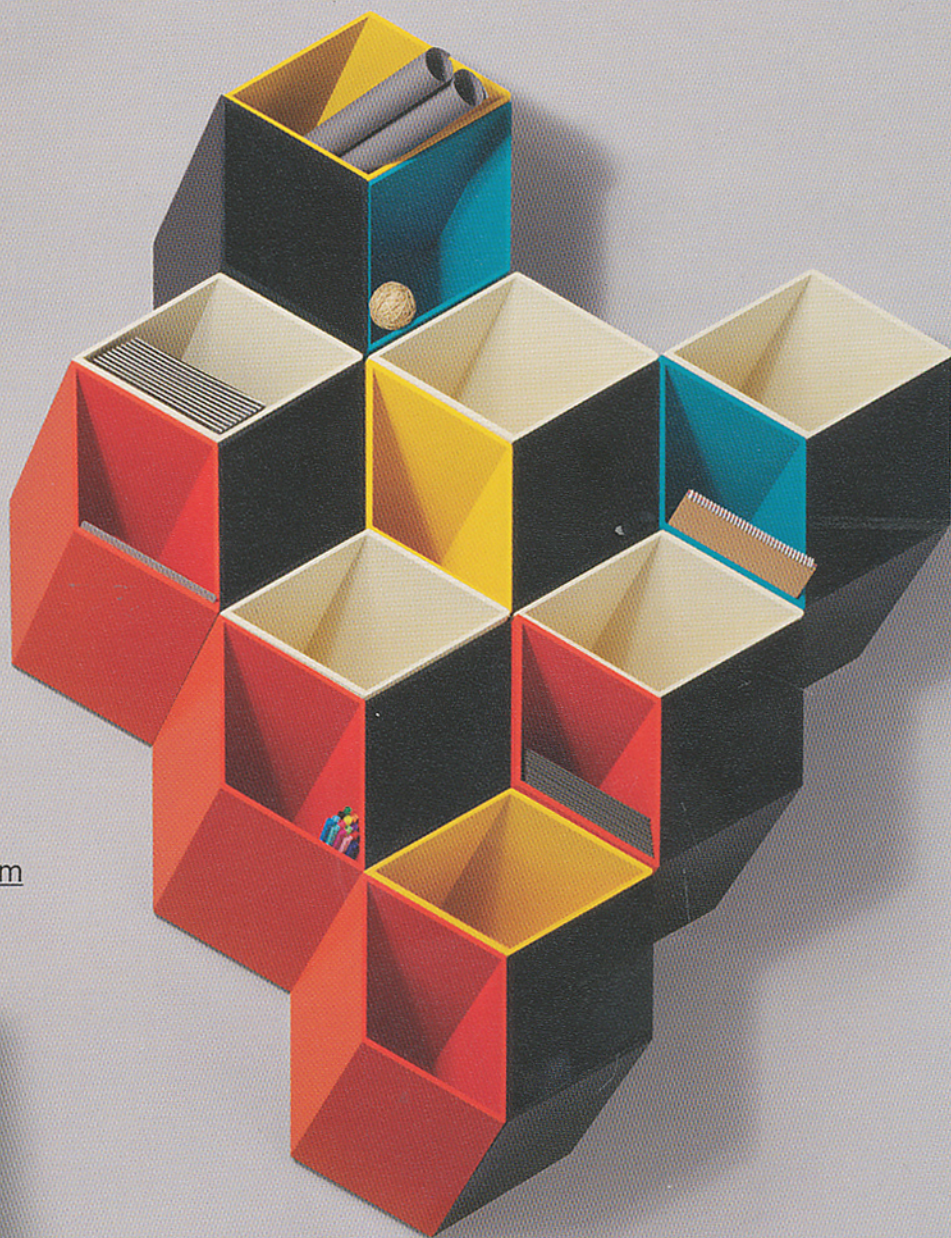
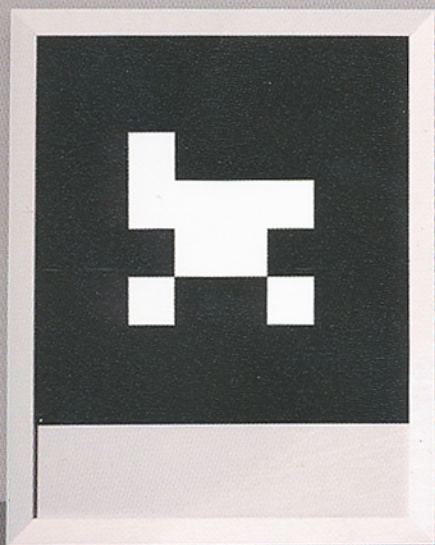

As this issue of Wallpaper* is dedicated to illuminating new talent, the light we chose to work by was crucial. The Bouroullecs' 'Lampada' not only looks good on our desks, its use of a rarely exploited material, sintered alumina, shows just the pioneering spirit we're after. It was the smooth white aesthetic of the material, normally used in the electronics and aerospace industries, as much as its non-conductive properties that inspired the Bouroullec brothers. The lamps come in three heights (55cm, 66cm, 77cm), each in an edition of 49. The future, we can see now, is bright. ★
